

Message from the President:

Welcome to April everyone! I consider this the start of the spring car season, when we can usually get to our first show or cruise-in.

The weather is all over the place obviously, but it's got to stop sometime right? I'm ready to get the car out! At our March meeting we had some interesting new discussions.

The first was about the Mopar swap meet at the Fairgrounds. We have decided for next year to make a change. We're going to go with only 3 cars for display, and open up the fourth for parts sales for our members. So think about putting your spare parts aside and keep them handy for next year. All we'll ask is that you donate maybe 10% of your sales or whatever you want to the club from any sales you make. That sounds fair enough.

The next discussion was a big one. We talked about changing our logo to a Mopar theme design rather than the Pentastar. So many of the up and coming new members may not even recognize the old Pentastar logo, that we thought that using the highly visible Mopar logo would offer greater recognition when we're out and about. We did some legal checking regarding the logo and found that many clubs are using it, and that there is no problem.



So please see attached the first small run of the new logo we'll use to get some feedback. A few people have seen it and they like it. These are heat seal embroidered patches that you can apply to most any apparel of your choice. I have experimented and have them on a jacket, a couple of short and long sleeve polo shirts and a 1/4 zip sweat shirt. It definitely pops.

I will bring some to the April meeting where you can purchase them for \$6.00. They cost \$5.00 each plus shipping. If the reaction is positive from everyone we can then start to change the website and Facebook page, and eventually have a t-shirt design where we can add our website and/or Facebook address with it. The embroidered patches are really too heavy for a t-shirt.

Another discussion we had that was important concerned our car show gifts. As you know we do both auction items and raffle items. Our discussion was that it is usually the same core of members that basically run our shows and do all the legwork to make them happen, with the goal of raising money for JDRF. Since we need prizes in order to run these events, we wanted the members to know that this involves a lot of extra work, by having to go out and solicit gifts. So it was suggested that we simply ask our members to help us out, by donating whatever they can or care to, in order to have these items available. If every member just came up with one thing it would be great, and any more would be highly appreciated. Our auction items are the slightly more expensive items that we can use to try and entice the showgoers to bid against each other. These items can be anything, not just car stuff or even guy stuff. The raffle items are the less expensive items we give away with the ticket they receive at registration. These items are generally in the \$5.00-\$20 range and are usually car oriented but they certainly don't have to be. Just something fun that they may pick. We'd like to start collecting these items by May and June for our shows in July and September. Just contact

anyone you know so that we can meet up to get them. It's all for a good cause, so whatever you can do is much appreciated. Money is fine too if you don't have time to shop. Thanks so much!

For those needing a local 'Car Vacation' weekend get-a-way during the cold and gloomy Indiana weather, the World of Wheels (WoW) is always a welcomed oasis of indoor sunshine.

This year there were some really nice '50s, '60s, '70s and later Mopars to see as well as other miscellaneous hot rods, muscle cars, rat rods and customs. There were even a pair of tiny little Crosleys, a wagon and a pick-up in the show.

The number of show entries appeared to be a bit lower this year than in the past but still filled the buildings with lots to see. Model cars, die casts, hats, shirts, car care products as well as other an assortment of other products were available to lighten your wallet or purse if you so desired.

A beautiful Hemi Superbird caught my eye when entering from the north entrance. Club President Jeff Platzer opened the meeting at 6:59pm.

Vice President Ronda Cherry took attendance. Those attending were Jeff Platzer, Ronda Cherry, Steve Wisdom, Jack Collins, Dick & Dorinda Crawmer, Tom Kelly, Ron Kriech, Dart & Donna Liebrandt, Randall Smith, Evan Springer, and Rick Zimmerman.

Secretary Dave Opel was not in attendance and Evan Springer was procured to take the minutes. (Cheerfully he accepted).

President Platzer asked for everyone's opinion of this year's Indy Cylinder Head Swap meet with the new schedule, attendance, layout, vendor participation and etc. It appeared that the consensus was very positive and better this year. Discussion ensued in reference to in the future the IMC having an area within the Club's allotted space to setup for sales of member's items "for sale". Ronda is to talk to Deanna and see if there would be any objections by the event providers.

Dr. Randy Smith gave the Communications Director's Report as follows:

He announced the photos from York Cruise-in have been posted to the website, and he located the missing July 2013 Newsletter and posted it to website.

In order to ensure no more email bounce-backs, he had to free up some space on our email. This entailed cultivating our most recent items and deleting any saved emails older than 2019. Going forward, I recommend only keeping emails from the preceding three years. Rather than running at full capacity every month, we are now running at about half of our email storage space.

He updated the following websites: Newsletters, Newsletters Archive, Events, Events Archive.He noted increasingly tricky fishing emails coming into the indymoparclub.com email. He noted that He receive on average about 50 spam emails a week to the club account.

He referenced the preceding Treasurer's Report, noting that Treasurer Wisdom had reimbursed him for the website renewal (\$287.00) and indymoparclub.com domain name renewal (\$67.18).

Vice President Ronda Cherry gave the member news and information on April birthdays and anniversaries.

Tom Kelly stated that he has updated some of the dates on the events calendar and requested verification of various dates and times for other known weekly cruise-ins. He especially mentioned Martinsville and Mooresville

(Thursdays?)weekly cruise-ins. Various ideas and suggestions for get-togethers, trips and cruise-ins were thrown around. To organize and document these ideas and info, please contact Tom Kelly with any ideas, dates and times so he can make note, list and organize suggestions. He may then be able to make notice of these possible activities at future meetings.

President Jeff Platzer mentioned that we need to secure the dates and times for the "York Cruise-In". Vice President Ronda Cherry will check in to this and solidify date and time. Treasurer Wisdom stated that the "Fletcher Cruise-In" date is a go for July 9, 2022 and the time will be 10:00am to 2:00pm. It was decided that the time frame for the "York Cruise-In" will also be set for 10:00am to 2:00pm. Storage trailer... Suggestion was made concerning the ability to keep all the various pieces of the ICM's equipment, storage tubs, albums, files and etc. altogether in one space or area. Once again it was suggested that it would be great to have a small mobile trailer to house all this club property that presently is located in various places around and within some of the members possession. Various conversations included considerable costs, place to keep the trailer, insurance and etc. Thought was it would be a good idea but there was no conclusion and was tabled for now.

President Jeff Platzer initiated discussion on a possible IMC Logo change or update, one that might make a more identifiable marketing tool utilizing the circular Mopar "M" with the "Indy Mopar Club" title under-line. The major concern was wondering if there might be a "Registered Trademark" infringement possibility using the "MOPAR M" logo. There didn't seem to be any objections. President Platzer stated that he would check further into the legality concerns. Tabled till further information was acquired.

President Platzer mentioned the need to get more of the membership involved in supporting and assisting in the Indy Mopar Club's activities. More help is need in various ways at IMC events. He asked all to consider ways to get more participation from all our membership. Treasurer Wisdom and President Platzer are to look into acquisition of items for raffles, prizes and drawings.


